## Early Release Day "Fun Lunches:"

Needham School Nutrition Services is implementing a new lunch plan for Early Release Days. In the past, no lunch was available on Early Release Days, but there are more of them this year than in the past, and we want students to have the option of having food available on these half days.

On Wednesday, September $25^{\text {th }}$ the debut of "FUN LUNCH" will occur. A Fun Lunch consists of a colorful paper bag filled with individually wrapped foods that don't have to be refrigerated, and make up a
nutritionally complete and FUN lunch. At Eliot the FUN LUNCH bag will include:

- Mozzarella string cheese
- Baby Carrots with Lite Ranch Dip
- Harvest Cheddar Sunchips
- $100 \%$ juice
- Cinnamon or Chocolate Granola
- Shelf stable chocolate or white milk will be available, if wanted.
- ...and a FUN SURPRISE in the bag.

The day before, a basket with the contents of the FUN LUNCH will be on display in each cafeteria, so students can see what they'll get when they order lunch.

The cost of the lunch will be the same as a regular lunch.

## Breakfast

A "Grab and Go" breakfast is available for purchase by all students every morning from 8:00-8:20 am. Students can grab a breakfast in the cafeteria and bring it to their classrooms to eat prior to starting their day.

## Morning Drop off

As a reminder, students may enter the building at 8:05 am and the morning bell rings at $8: 20$ to begin the school day. If there is traffic in the car line, we will not mark your child tardy. We strongly encourage families to stay in their cars during the morning drop off and not use the crosswalk in front of the building unless necessary. This will help us keep the traffic flowing and help all students enter the building on time. If parents would like to drive to Eliot and walk students to the building, Ardmore and Taylor Streets are good places to park. We ask that you not drop your child off prior to 8:05 unless they are enrolled in the NEDP program. Students left outside prior to 8:05 are unsupervised. Thank you!
