Dear Eliot Families,

We had a wonderful start of in-person learning this week. Students were very happy to be back in the building and did a wonderful job acclimating to the new procedures in place to keep them safe. We are so incredibly proud of all of them. Our teachers have been working very hard to make this a successful start. Many have commented on how they are "working harder than ever" as they maintain their high standards of teaching and learning students at home and in the building while working in this new environment. Here are a few notes:

RACIAL LITERACY LESSON

Over the next two weeks, Eliot students will discuss the Health crisis and not associating the virus with a specific cultural group. As mentioned in the Spring, there was an unfortunate incident involving a child of Asian descent who was asked if they had the virus, by another child. The student who made the comment may have been repeating what they heard in the media. Regardless of the other child's intention, the child of Asian descent felt targeted and blamed due to her race and that is not acceptable.

Now that students are in-person, we feel we must address the targeting of Asian Americans and the virus with all kids. Teachers will discuss how this pandemic is not attributed to a specific group of people, especially Asian and Chinese Americans. We will discuss how blaming a specific group of people for the pandemic is in fact a form of discrimination. It is our hope that conversations from home and at school will help kids have a better understanding of this virus and will help all children feel safe and welcomed.
