The Needham Education Foundation (NEF) is now accepting applications for both small and large grants. All applications are due by Tuesday, October 20, 2020. Any Needham Public School educator, administrator or community member — including students and parents — is

eligible to apply. There will be two more opportunities to submit applications this year: January 19 and April 13, 2021.

- Small grants fund projects up to \$5,000
- Large grants fund projects up to \$15,000

Within small grants, the NEF offers two additional options:

- Express grants allow applicants to apply for a program already funded by the NEF at another school
- Multi-School grants allow schools to apply together without the constraints of the small grant funding limit (up to \$3,000 per school)
