- 1. Fiscal Year 2023 budget
 - a. Converted Assistant Principal to full time
 - b. Needing teaching assistants for support
 - i. Fully included in planning for the classroom and providing assistance with academics
 - ii. Currently 5 assistant liaisons that are embedded in a particular area
 - iii. Need a 0.6 assistant position for kindergarten for a true inclusion
 - c. Guidance counselor to provide social emotional support and assist teachers
 - Need a shared who has access to town resources to assist families in need
 - 1. Most marginalized families end up not getting bussing services
 - 2. No longer have access to police officer who acted as liaison for the schools that can check in with families in subsidized housing
 - 3. Position would be a shared resource
- 2. Eagle Block ensures students have the required academic skills
 - a. New program created focusing currently on 2nd and 4th grade literacy and math with materials that are science based
 - i. 2nd grade was selected based on data obtained
 - ii. 4th grade was selected based on math shifting to being conceptual
 - 1. Data analysis on math showed 5th graders were having issues with fractions which is covered in 4th grade
 - b. Meet with students in small groups and identifying areas where additional support is needed for certain students
 - c. Conducting pre and post week assessments for each 8 week groups to track improvements
 - i. No way to measure growth yet
 - d. Goal is a reduction in special education referrals for 4th grade
